TGA team event tees off Saturday

The Texas Golf Association's first statewide competition of 2007, the Club Team Championship, will be held Saturday and Sunday at The Club at Comanche Trace.

Member clubs from around the state send their three best mid-amateur players (age 25 or older) to compete in the 36-hole event.

The format for the Club Team consists of all three team members playing two rounds of stroke play, with the two lowest scores counting towards their daily total.

In addition to state bragging rights, teams will be vying for the Rotan Cup, which is presented to the champions for display at their home club. For the past two years, Hollytree Country Club in Tyler has owned the silver trophy — named in honor of George V. Rotan, a five-time winner of the Texas Amateur and a member of the 1923 Walker Cup Team.

Comanche Trace GM Trevor Hyde, Scott Parker and Paul Manziel will team to represent the host course in the event.
